HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1564, L.D. 2170, Bill, "An Act to Continue the Effort to Preserve
and Promote Affordable Housing and Economic Opportunities for
Maine People"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the
following:

'Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §13081, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 534,
Pt. A, §§17 and 19, is amended to read:

6. Local development corporation. "Local development
corporation" means any nonprofit organization created by a
municipality; incorporated under Title 13, chapter 81;
incorporated under Title 13-B or otherwise chartered by the
State; and designed to foster, encourage and assist the
settlement or resettlement of industrial, manufacturing, fishing,
agricultural, recreational and other business enterprises within
the State. A majority vote of the municipal officers is
sufficient to form a local development corporation,
notwithstanding Title 13, chapter 81. Notwithstanding this
subsection, a "local development corporation" is any nonprofit
organization incorporated under Title 13, chapter 81;
incorporated under Title 13-B or otherwise chartered by the
State; and designed to foster, encourage and assist the
settlement or resettlement of industrial, manufacturing, fishing,
agricultural, recreational and other business enterprises within
the State that applies for financial assistance for a project
under this article, as long as that application is formally
endorsed by a vote of the governing body of the municipality in
which the project is to be located.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment expands the definition of "local development
corporation" to include a nonprofit organization applying for
financial assistance for a community industrial building project,
as long as the application is endorsed by a vote of the governing
body of the municipality in which the project is to be located.
