An Act to Amend the Financial Responsibility Law Pertaining to Motor Vehicles.



Be it	enacted	by	the	People	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §790, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 341, §§5 and 7, is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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The law requiring all motor vehicles to be covered by liability insurance or other evidence of financial responsibility went into effect January 1, 1988, for a 3-year trial period. It was then amended in 1989 to remove the "24-hour loophole." This bill repeals the expiration date and leaves the existing law unchanged. This bill is intended to be a vehicle for legislative review of the financial responsibility law as the trial period comes to an end.

This bill also repeals the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 790, which required a survey of persons injured in uninsured motorist accidents. That survey has been completed.

This bill is presented as a result of a study by a subcommittee of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance, pursuant to Legislative Council authorization.
