16	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
18	enacting clause the following:
20	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
22	as emergencies; and
24	Whereas, provisions of this Act govern the considerations of arbitrators under the Maine Agricultural Marketing and Bargaining
26	Act of 1973; and
28	Whereas, negotiations leading to arbitration may occur before adjournment of the Legislature; and
30	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
32	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
34	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
36	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.
38	
40	Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 5 in paragraph A by striking out all of the 2nd sentence (page 3, lines 16 to 19 in L.D.).
42	
44	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
46	' <b>Emergency clause.</b> In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
48	
50	Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

## STATEMENT OF FACT This amendment deletes portions of the bill establishing a written mediator's report and references to the report's use by an arbitrator. The amendment adds an emergency preamble and clause so new language providing guidance to arbitrators will be available, if needed, for bargaining this spring.
