HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1575, L.D. 2182, Bill, "An Act to Regulate the Handling of Manure"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1,
line 28 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
"testimony" the following: 'to the Legislature'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 5th
paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§2701-B." by inserting after subsection 3 the following:

'4. Procedure. An investigation or other action under this
section may be taken only after notice and hearing and utilizing
the requirements of Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter IV.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 6th
paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§2701-B." in the 3rd paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 40
in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section." and inserting
in its place the following: 'section, including a definition of
"generally accepted manure handling practices."'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment imposes the requirements of the Maine
Administrative Procedure Act on a manure investigation.
