22	'If the commissioner finds that improper manure handling may
24	have affected water quality and the person responsible does not adopt generally accepted manure handling practices, the
26	<u>commissioner shall advise the Commissioner of Environmental</u> <u>Protection that a potential water guality violation exists and</u>
28	<u>the Commissioner of Environmental Protection may respond as appropriate.'</u>

34	This amendment strikes the Senate amendment and consolidates language concerning the relationship between the Commissioner of
36	Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection in situations when manure handling
38	practices may affect water quality.
