HOUSE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1577, L.D. 2184, Bill, "An Act
Regarding Written Notice to Employees of Layoff or Termination"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§630." in subsection
2 by inserting at the end the following: '<u>This subsection</u>
18 applies to employers of 10 or more employees.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>§630.</u>" in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>this section</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>subsection 2</u>'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>§630.</u>" in subsection 4 by striking out all of the last 2 sentences.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits to employers of 10 or more employees the provision requiring notification of reasons for discharge. This amendment also eliminates the availability of attorney's fees and court costs in addition to a forfeiture in the penalty provisions and limits the applicability of that provision to subsection 2.
