SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1583, L.D. 2192, Bill, "An Act to Reduce the Use of Toxic
Substances in the Workplace and Minimize the Generation of
Hazardous Waste"

Amend the amendment in section 7 in that part designated
"~~S2303.~~" in subsection 2 in the 7th line (page 6, line 52 in
amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "are" the
underlined word 'not'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2303.~~" in subsection 2 in the 8th line (page 7, line
1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "goals. These
reduction requirements" and inserting in its place the following:
'goals, but must examine, plan and implement means of reducing
the release of toxics without impairing the production or quality
of their products or services. These reduction goals'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2304.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph G in
subparagraph (2) by striking out all of the last 2 sentences
(page 8, lines 49 to 51 and page 9, lines 1 to 3 in amendment)
and inserting in their place the following: 'A generator is not
entitled to a renewal based solely on the fact that a legal or
contractual obligation has been renewed.'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2304.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2.

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2307.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2 and
inserting in its place the following:

'2. Toxics release reduction reports. As set forth in
Title 37-B, section 799, toxics releasers must report their

progress toward meeting the toxics release reduction goals as
part of their reporting requirements to the State Emergency
Response Commission.'


Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2307.~~" in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 12,
line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2 or"

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2307.~~" in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the 2nd and
3rd lines (page 12, lines 43 and 44 in amendment) by striking out
the following: "toxics releaser or" and in the 6th line (page 12,
line 47 in amendment) by striking out the following: "toxics
releaser or" and in the next to last line (page 12, line 50 in
amendment) by striking out the following: "toxics releaser or"

Further amend the amendment in section 7 in that part
designated "~~S2307.~~" in subsection 7 in the 3rd line (page 13,
line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "toxics
releaser or"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains toxics release reduction goals, but
makes goals nonmandatory as they are for toxics use. Toxics
releasers are still required to examine, plan and implement means
of reducing releases.
