SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1589, L.D. 2201, Bill, "An Act to Create the Maine Coast Environmental Trust Fund"

Amend the amendment in section 6 in that part designated "~~§13130.~~" in subsection 3 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 3, line 20 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 6 in that part designated "~~§13130.~~" in subsection 3 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

The Maine Science and Technology Commission will be able to absorb the cost of 2 new members on the Marine Research Board within the commission's existing resources. This bill also establishes the Maine Coast Environmental Trust Fund. No additional General Fund appropriations will be required. Income to the trust fund will be additional dedicated revenue. Neither the amount nor the timing of the additional dedicated revenue can be determined.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment clarifies that no General Fund appropriations will be required to fund the grants program of the Maine Coast Environmental Trust Fund.
