12 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1595, L.D. 2212, Bill, "An Act to Establish Mediation for Mobile Home Park Operators and Tenants"

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Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause 18 (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§9097-B." in 22 subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "90" and inserting in its place the 24 following: '30'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "\$9097-B." in subsection 1, paragraph C in the 4th line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "90-day" and inserting in its place the following: '30-day'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "**§9097-B.**" in 32 subsection 7 in the 5th line (page 2, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or" and inserting in its place the 34 following: 'and'

36 Further amend the bill in that part designated "<u>\$9097-B.</u>" by inserting after subsection 7 the following:

Application. This section applies only to owners and
tenants of mobile home parks licensed for 250 or more individual
mobile home lots.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "**§9097-B**." in 44 subsection 8 in the first line (page 3, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>8</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>9</u>'

48 Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

The remaining \$8,500 will be funded by the board's uncommitted 40 balance forward. The board may require an increase in its 42 statutory limit to fund potential future deficits.' 44 STATEMENT OF FACT 46 The amendment shortens from 90 to 30 days the notice of 48 changes in lot rental amount or reduction in services or utilities or park rules that a park owner must give the tenants 50 before implementing those changes.

2 The amendment limits the application of the bill's mediation procedures to mobile home parks licensed for 250 or more 4 individual mobile home lots.
