HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1602, L.D. 2214, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Role of the Board of Environmental Protection"

Amend the amendment by inserting before the 2nd indented paragraph before **Part B** the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**Sec. 39. Board membership; transition.** Members of the Board of Environmental Protection on the effective date of this Act may serve the remainder of their terms as provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, former section 361.

**Sec. 40. Application.** This Act does not apply to any license or permit proceeding, appeal, reconsideration, or other action pending before the Department of Environmental Protection on the effective date of this Act.' '

Further amend the amendment in the 2nd indented paragraph before **Part B** in the last line (page 6, line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A-38." and inserting in its place the following: 'A-40.'

Further amend the amendment in section B-44 in subsection 3 in the 16th line (page 32, line 51 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "commissioner" the following: ', after notice and hearing.'

Further amend the amendment in section B-45 in subsection 4 in the first line (page 33, line 19 in amendment) by inserting

2 after the following: "If" the following: 'the commissioner  
3 determines, after notice and hearing, that' and in the 2nd and
