2. Investment of funds. Money in the Board of
Environmental Protection Fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the board in the exercise of its responsibilities
18 under this Title must be deposited with the Treasurer of State to the credit of the fund and may be invested as provided by law.
20 Interest on these investments must be credited to the fund.' '
