22	'Notwithstanding section 972, subsection 2, the Attorney General shall provide all legal services related to the
24	implementation of this subchapter, provided that the authority may, with the approval of the Attorney General, employ private
26	legal counsel to provide those services.''

30	STATEMENT OF FACT
32	This amendment clarifies the original intent of the bill by specifying that, as at present, all legal services relating to
34	the higher education loan programs that are part of the Student Financial Assistance Program must be provided by the Attorney
36	General. The amendment also authorizes the Finance Authority of Maine to retain private legal counsel to assist with the program
38	with the approval of the Attorney General.
