COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $A$ " to H.P. 1610, L.D. 2226, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Military and Naval Children's Home"
Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated " $5253-A_{x}$ " by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:
'1. Chief administrative officer. The chief administrative officer of the Bath Children's Home is the director. The director must have sufficient education and experience to administer a facility providing services to children in need of treatment.'
Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated " <u>\$6253-A.</u> " in subsection 6 in paragraph A in subparagraph (3) in the first line (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>The Bath Elementary School</u> " and inserting in its place the following: ' <u>A Bath school</u> '

This amendment removes the provision of the bill requiring 38 that the Director of the Bath Children's Home serve at the pleasure of the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental 40 Retardation. It also removes the requirement that the member of the Board of Visitors for the Bath Children's Home who is a Bath 42 school principal be the principal of an elementary school.
