HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1613, L.D. 2230, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Negotiability of Sabbatical Leave Agreements"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§13604." in the first line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Leaves of absence" and inserting in its place the following: 'Sabbatical leave'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§13604." in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 42 in amendment) by inserting after the underlined word "conditions" the following: ', except that such terms and conditions are not subject to binding arbitration as provided in Title 26, section 965, subsection 4'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that the terms and conditions of leaves of absence established by school boards are not subject to binding arbitration.
