SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 885, L.D. 2254, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Special Commission to Study the Organization of the State's Cultural Agencies"

Amend the bill in Part B, in section B-42, by striking out all that part designated "~~§554.~~" (page 66, lines 43 to 48 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

§554. Staff

The directors and the personnel of the cultural agencies shall provide staff assistance to the Maine State Cultural Affairs Council.

Further amend the bill in Part B, in section B-42, by striking out all that part designated "~~§558.~~" (page 68, lines 18 to 47 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of section B-51.

Further amend the bill in Part B by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Maine Arts Commission, the Maine Historic Preservation Commission, the Maine State Library and the Maine State Museum will be able to absorb the expenses of the Maine State Cultural Affairs Council within existing budgeted resources. 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STATEMENT OF FACT

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10 This amendment removes language that would have created an  
11 executive secretary position within the Maine State Cultural  
12 Affairs Council and eliminates the appropriation section relating  
13 to that position.
