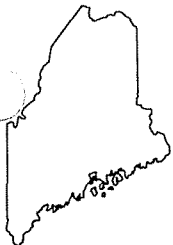

An Act to Amend the Law Concerning the Hunting of Coyote.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 12 MRSA §7108, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1987, c. 684, §2, is further amended to read:

6 3. Open season. Notwithstanding section 7406, subsection
8 5, ~~there shall be~~ an open season for hunting coyotes at night in
10 all counties of the State from January 1st to April 30th ~~in 1989~~
12 ~~and 1990 and January 1st to March 31st thereafter~~ is
14 established. The commissioner may terminate this open season at
16 any time in any area if, in his the commissioner's opinion, an
18 immediate emergency action is necessary due to adverse weather
20 conditions or illegal hunting activity.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill ensures that the present 4-month coyote hunting season remains in effect beyond the year 1990.
