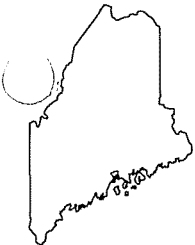

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2                   22 MRSA §7307 is enacted to read:

4                   **§7307. Relatives as providers**

6                   The department may not refuse to pay a relative of an adult  
8                   with long-term care needs for the provision of in-home and  
10                   community support services or personal care assistance services  
                  if the relative is qualified to provide the service.

12                   STATEMENT OF FACT

14                   This bill permits payment to relatives for the provision of  
16                   in-home and community support services and personal care
