## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment implements several steps to reduce the cost of the Commission to Assess the Impact of Increased State Spending on the University of Maine System, including removing the provision of per diem for Legislators. The amendment removes the General Fund appropriation and the legislative staffing requirement and requires the University of Maine System to absorb the remaining costs of the commission.
