HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 894,
L.D. 2276, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Natural Resources
Protection Act"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 8-A in the
first line (page 1, line 41 in amendment) by striking out the
following: "Reconstruction" and inserting in its place the
following: 'Transportation reconstruction'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 8-A
in the 2nd line (page 1, line 42 in amendment) by striking out
the following: "Reconstruction" and inserting in its place the
following: 'Transportation reconstruction'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part
designated "§480-H." in subsection 1 by striking out the first
paragraph (page 2, lines 27 to 32 in amendment) and inserting in
its place the following:

'1. Department of Transportation projects. By February 15,
1991, requirements for projects that are under the direction and
supervision of the Department of Transportation that do not
affect coastal wetlands or coastal sand dune systems and that
involve only maintenance or repair of public transportation
facilities or structures, or transportation reconstruction or
replacement projects.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part
designated "§480-H." in subsection 1 in paragraph A by striking
out the first paragraph (page 2, lines 34 to 36 in amendment) and
inserting in its place the following:

'A. The Department of Transportation shall meet the
following conditions for any project undertaken pursuant to
this subsection after February 15, 1991.'

2 Further amend the amendment in section 3 in that part
designated "S480-T." in the first paragraph (page 3, line 19 in
4 amendment) by inserting before the following: "reconstruction"
the following: 'transportation'
