COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1652, L.D. 2285, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Pertaining to Preadmission Assessment"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§7910." in the first paragraph by adding at the end a new sentence to read: 'The department may limit reimbursement for an individual only if another permanent residence with appropriate services is available for that individual.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment permits the Department of Human Services to limit reimbursement for cost-reimbursed boarding homes to individuals who are determined to need that level of care only if another permanent residence with appropriate services is available.
