16	Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out the last sentence (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its
18	place the following: 'This prohibition does not apply to:
20	1. Rights-of-way. Utility or transportation rights-of-way:
22	2. Government purchase. A parcel of land that is purchased by the Federal Government, State Government or local government;

26	3. Public benefit. A parcel of land that the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission finds provides a significant public benefit

34	This amendment allows additional exemptions to the spaghetti-lot prohibition enacted by the bill to allow for narrow
36	lots for such purposes as public boat launches and wildlife travel corridors.
