COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1655, L.D. 2291, Bill, "An Act to Protect Health Insurance Coverage for Citizens on Jury Duty"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1218.~~" in the first paragraph in the 4th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "summons" the following: 'for jury service'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1218.~~" in the first paragraph in the next to the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the summons" and inserting in its place the following: 'a summons for jury service'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§2332-D.~~" in subsection 1 in the next to the last line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "summoned" and inserting in its place the following: 'summonsed'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§2848.~~" in subsection 1 in the next to the last line (page 2, line 1 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "summoned" and inserting in its place the following: 'summonsed'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill may increase the workload of District Court clerks and judges. However, these additional costs can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

6 This amendment clarifies that employees are protected when  
they receive or respond to a summons for jury duty only, not for  
other types of summonses. The amendment clarifies that persons  
8 acting under a summons are summonsed. The amendment also adds a  
fiscal note.
