STATEMENT OF FACT

16 The bill requires all health insurance contracts and policies to include coverage for screening mammograms, which are 18 tests for detecting breast cancer. The American Cancer Society recommends that the tests be given once between the ages of 35 20 and 40 to establish a base line for comparison to later tests, once every 2 years from ages 40 to 49, and annually for ages 50 22 and over. Several organizations, including the American Medical Association and the National Cancer Institute, endorse that The bill excludes the base line mammogram, but 24 schedule. includes the schedule for mammograms for ages 40 and over.

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
