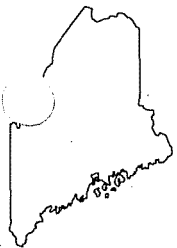

**An Act to Extend the Reporting Date of the Commission on Codification of Rules.**

(EMERGENCY)  
(After Deadline)



2           **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not  
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted  
as emergencies; and

6           Whereas, Public Law 1989, chapter 574, section 10,  
subsection 5, became effective on September 30, 1989 and set a  
March 15, 1990 reporting deadline for the Commission on  
8 Codification of Rules to report its findings and recommendations  
for a code of rules to the Joint Standing Committee on State and  
10 Local Government; and

12           Whereas, the commission requires additional time in order to  
develop appropriate recommendations; and

16           Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
18 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety; now, therefore,

20           **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

22                   **PL 1989, c. 574, §10, sub-§5** is amended to read:

26           5. The commission shall report its findings and its  
recommendation for a code of rules to the Joint Standing  
Committee on State and Local Government no later than March  
28 September 15, 1990.

30           **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

36           This bill extends the reporting deadline of the Commission  
38 on Codification of Rules in reporting its recommendation for a  
code of rules to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
