HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1660, L.D. 2300, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Organizational Structure of the Fish and Wildlife Advisory Council"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Improve the Organizational Structure of the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~7033-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd paragraph by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 2, lines 18 to 23 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'A Legislator may not serve as a member of the advisory council. A former Legislator who was a member of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over fisheries and wildlife matters may not serve as a member of the advisory council prior to the expiration of one year from that former Legislator's last day of membership on that committee.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits a Legislator from serving on the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council while a member of the Legislature. The amended version still requires a period of one year after service on the Joint Standing Committee on Fisheries and Wildlife before a former Legislator may serve on the advisory council.
