SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1665, L.D. 2305, Bill, "An Act
Allowing the Yarmouth Water District to Acquire the Assets and
Liabilities of the North Yarmouth Water District"

Amend the bill in section 12 in the first line (page 3, line
48 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "; effective date" and
in the 3rd line (page 4, line 1 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "within" and inserting in its place the following:
'before or within'


Further amend the bill in section 12 in the 2nd paragraph
from the end in the first and 2nd lines (page 4, lines 23 and 24
in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall take effect for
all purposes immediately upon its acceptance" and inserting in
its place the following: 'shall not take effect unless accepted'

Further amend the bill in section 13 in the first line (page
4, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Effective
date." and inserting in its place the following: 'Retroactivity;
effective date. Sections 1 to 3 and sections 5 to 12 of this Act
take effect March 7, 1990, and are retroactive to that date.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes technical changes in the bill to enable
the Town of North Yarmouth's March 10, 1990 referendum vote to be
fully effective.
