26 Treatment and Research Fund are adjusted so that allocations remain within budgeted revenue.

The amounts transferred, allocated and appropriated in this 30 bill may be subject to adjustment based on the effect of other bills enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 114th 32 Legislature. In particular, some of the General Fund appropriations included in this bill have been proposed for 34 reductions in the Governor's supplemental budget.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the portion of the bill that would 40 undedicate revenue and changes the fiscal note and appropriation section.
