Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page
1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "develop" and
inserting in its place the following: 'investigate'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th line (page
1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "children"
the following: 'under 7 years of age'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the first line
(page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**study**"
and inserting in its place the following: '**investigate**'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the 3rd line (page
1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "study" and
inserting in its place the following: 'investigate'

Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the last line
(page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1991."
and inserting in its place the following: '1991; and be it
further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the statement
of fact the following:

'**Sec. 4. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
