Resolve, Directing the Department of Human Services to Develop a Poison Warning System .

(After Deadline)



- Sec. 1. Department of Human Services directed to develop poison warning program. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services is directed to develop a poison warning symbol and program designed to educate and alert children to the dangers associated with ingesting, inhaling or touching certain household products; and be it further
- Sec. 2. Department of Human Services to study alternative methods of financing. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services is directed to study methods of financing the poison warning program that will involve the participation of the private sector, including, but not limited to, the financial sponsorship of the program by one or more private business concerns; and be it further
- Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services is directed to submit a report on its proposed poison warning program, including recommendations for implementation and funding, to the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources no later than January 31, 1991.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2.8

This resolve directs the Department of Human Services to develop a poison warning program to alert children to the dangers associated with ingesting, inhaling or touching certain household products. The resolve also directs the Department of Human Services to investigate alternative methods of financing the program, including financial sponsorship by private business concerns.
