COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 916, L.D. 2322, Bill, "An Act Creating the Long Pond Water District"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. Territorial limits; corporate name; purposes. Subject to section 17 of this Act, the inhabitants and territory of those parts of the Town of Sullivan and the Town of Sorrento composed of the area beginning at a point 1,500 feet north of the intake pipe of Long Pond; thence easterly to a point intersecting with the western branch of Flanders Stream; thence in a southerly direction following Flanders Stream until the outlet in Flanders Bay; thence west following Flanders Bay to a point 500 feet east of the transmission main; thence south to the shore of Flanders Bay; thence following this shoreline in a southerly and southwesterly direction; thence northerly around Waukeag Neck; thence easterly to the end of Long Cove; thence easterly to a point intersecting Route 185; thence northerly along Route 185 to the intersection of U.S. Route 1 and Route 185; thence easterly along U.S. Route 1 to a point 500 feet west of the intersection of the Pumpkinville Road and U.S. Route 1; thence northerly to the southern tip of Long Pond; thence north along the eastern shore to the point of beginning, constitute a quasi-municipal corporation under the name of "Long Pond Water District" for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants and others of the district with pure water for domestic, sanitary, commercial, industrial, agricultural and municipal purposes.'

Further amend the bill in section 13 by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph (page 7, lines 23 to 28 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All bonds, notes and evidences of indebtedness so issued by the district, which is declared to be a quasi-municipal corporation, are legal obligations of the district within the meaning of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5701.'

2 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

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FISCAL NOTE

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8 The Public Utilities Commission will incur some minor
additional administrative costs that can be absorbed within the
commission's existing budgeted resources.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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16 This amendment corrects the language in section 1 of the
bill, establishing the water district, adds a reference and
deletes redundant language in section 13 and adds a fiscal note.
