SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 916, L.D. 2322, Bill, "An Act
Creating the Long Pond Water District"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, an adequate supply of pure water is essential to
the health and well-being of the inhabitants of the Town of
Sullivan and the Town of Sorrento; and

Whereas, it is desirable that a public district be formed in
parts of those towns to be able to supply water to the people of
the area; and

Whereas, it is vital that this be done at once for the
benefit of the people of the area; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '
