SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to S.P. 916, L.D. 2322, Bill, "An Act
Creating the Long Pond Water District"

Amend the bill before the enacting clause by inserting the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, the creation of the Long Pond Water District must
be voted on in town meetings that will be held before the
expiration of the 90-day period; and

Whereas, it is necessary for the Long Pond Water District to
undertake construction during the current construction season; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by adding at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
