16	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
18	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
20	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
22	as emergencies; and
24	Whereas, potatoes will be planted within 60 days of adjournment; and
26	Whereas, the benefits received by the State as a result of
28	the certified seed potato program depend on the continued cooperation of farmers with the Department of Agriculture, Food
30	and Rural Resources; and
	Whereas, this cooperation is threatened under existing
32	circumstances; and
34	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
36	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
38	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
10	Further amend the bill in the first paragraph after the
	amending clause in the 9th and 10th lines (page 1, lines 14 and
12	15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "for a violation of
	criminal law." and inserting in its place the following: 'for a
14	criminal violation. A grower may authorize in writing the disclosure of records pertaining to minimum standards for
16	planting.'

4	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the

12	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and clause, adds a provision to allow growers to authorize release of planting
14	records and makes a technical change in the original bill.
