SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1692, L.D. 2342, Bill, "An Act to Promote Equity of Opportunity for Women in Administrative Positions in the Public School System"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S4576.~~" by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 1, lines 30 to 37 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 8 in the 4th line (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "on" and inserting in its place the following: 'for'

Further amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 9 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "on" and inserting in its place the following: 'for'

Further amend the amendment in section 6 by striking out all of subsection 14.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 14.

Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'The Maine Human Rights Commission has indicated it will absorb the costs associated with promoting gender equity and investigating complaints filed with the commission within budgeted resources and using existing staff.'
