Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

- Whereas, the status of the Maine economy has a dramatic impact on the stability of the State's finances; and
- 8 Whereas, the current economic slowdown demonstrates the critical relationship between the State's economy and the State's finances; and
- 12 Whereas, it is necessary to ensure the future stability of the State's finances; and

Whereas, increasing the maximum funding level of the Maine Rainy Day Fund will assist in accomplishing this goal; and

18 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 22 safety; now, therefore,

24 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §1513, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 448, is amended to read:

1. Maine Rainy Day Fund. The State Controller shall at the 30 close of each fiscal year transfer from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Rainy Day Fund an amount not to exceed 1/2 the excess of total General Fund revenues 32 received over accepted estimates in that fiscal year. No accepted revenue estimate shall may be increased after adjournment of each 34 First Regular Session of the Legislature except as provided. For the first year of the biennium, revenue estimates for the 2nd 36 year of the biennium may be adjusted once during the Second 38 Regular Session of the Legislature. Accepted revenue estimates may be increased for other fiscal periods only if 1/2 of the increase is appropriated to the Maine Rainy Day Fund at the same 40 time. The fund shall may not exceed \$25,000,000-which-shall 4% of the total General Fund revenues received in the immediately 42 preceding fiscal year and may not lapse, but must remain in a 44 continuing carrying account to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT
