20	Enactment of this legislation will result in:
20	1. An increase in revenue to the General Fund in the amount
22	of \$10,112 for fiscal year 1990-91. This revenue is based on a proposed one-time fee of \$10 assessed to an estimated 1,011 acres
24	leased for aquaculture purposes.
26	2. A General Fund appropriation to the Legislature in the amount of \$9,325 for fiscal year 1990-91. This appropriation
28	would provide funds for anticipated expenses for the study of the aquaculture industry.'

32	STATEMENT OF FACT
34	This amendment creates a one-time assessment of \$10 per acre on aquaculture leases in order to provide adequate funding for
36	the study established in the committee amendment. The amendment requires the committee to meet within 10 days of the effective
38	date, removes the emergency preamble and clause, makes other technical changes in the committee amendment and adds a fiscal
