STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Submission of Bills with Supplemental Appropriations.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA \$1666, as amended by PL 1989, c. 7, Pt. O, \$1, is further amended to read:

§1666. Review and revision of estimates

The Governor-elect or the Governor, with the assistance of the State Budget Officer, shall review the budget estimates, altering, revising, increasing or decreasing the items of the estimates as may-be-deemed determined necessary in view of the needs of the various departments and agencies and the total anticipated income of the State Government during the ensuing Such The review shall--cover covers all budgets regardless of the source of funds, including, but not limited to, budgets related to the Highway Fund, the Alcoholism Prevention, Treatment and Research Fund, the Federal Revenue Education, Sharing Fund, and other special revenue funds. The State Budget Officer, at the direction of the Governor-elect or the Governor, shall then prepare a state budget document in the form required The Governor-elect or the Governor shall be fully by law. responsible for all budgetary recommendations made to Legislature. The Governor shall transmit the budget document to the Legislature not later than the Friday following the first Monday in January of the first regular legislative session. that time the Governor shall also transmit any emergency bills which that authorize additional appropriations or allocations in the current fiscal year that the Governor may wish to propose. For the second regular legislative session, the Governor shall transmit any bills that authorize supplemental appropriations or allocations for the remainder of the biennium not later than the Friday following the first Monday in January. A Governor-elect elected to a first term of office shall transmit the budget document to the Legislature not later than the Friday following the first Monday in February of the first regular legislative At that time the Governor-elect shall also transmit any emergency bills which that authorize additional appropriations or allocations in the current fiscal year that the Governor may wish to propose.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Governor to transmit any supplemental budget bills to a second regular legislative session in early January, as required for Parts 1 and 2 of the state budget document and emergency budget bills during the first regular legislative session. The bill also makes technical changes to conform this section to current statutory usage.
