SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to H.P. 1711, L.D. 2362, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Maine State Lottery to Enter into an Agreement with Other States to Join the Multi-State Lottery Association, Known as Lotto\*America, for the Purpose of Operating a Joint Lottery"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:


'Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §372, sub-§2, ¶I, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 505, §2, is amended to read:

I. Carry on a continuous study and investigation of the lotteries throughout the State and the operation and administration of similar laws which that may be in effect in other states or countries.

Sec. 3. Effective date; repeal. Section 1 of this Act is repealed and section 2 of this Act takes effect 3 years after the effective date of this Act.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment places a 3-year sunset on the authority granted to the State Lottery Director to participate in Lotto\*America.
