36 MRSA §656, sub-§1, ¶J is enacted to read:

J. Any ramp or other appurtenance or device attached or adjacent to a residence for the sole purpose of making the residence accessible to persons with physical disabilities is exempt from taxation to the extent that an increase on the value of real property is attributable to the ramp, appurtenance or device.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides a real estate tax exemption for ramps and other devices used on residences to make them accessible to persons with physical disabilities. This exemption applies only to the extent that a ramp or other device would increase the value of the real estate.
