SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 937, L.D. 2372, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Use of Funds Raised by Organizations Operating Games of Chance or Beano"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 51 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "Act" the following: ', Title 5, chapter 375'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 41 in L.D.) by inserting after the word "Act" the following: ', Title 5, chapter 375'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:


FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this bill would require the Department of Public Safety to implement an application process that would provide financial assistance to individuals with serious illness, injury or casualty loss. The Department of Public Safety has indicated that all costs associated with the implementation of this bill, including rulemaking, would be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes 2 technical changes to reference more accurately the rule-making provisions of the Maine Administrative Procedure Act. The amendment adds a fiscal note.

These changes were inadvertently not included in a committee amendment. This amendment is in lieu of the committee amendment.
