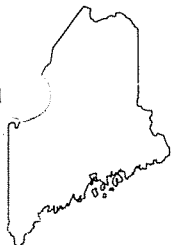

**An Act to Institute the National Assessment of Educational Progress
Program in Maine Schools.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §6202, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. National Assessment of Educational Progress Program.
Beginning in the 1991 school year, National Assessment of
Educational Progress Program tests must be administered in
academic areas at the various grades designated by the National
Assessment of Educational Progress Program. Schools selected are
required to participate in the program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires selected schools to participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress Program beginning in the 1991 school year.
