The General Fund appropriations and deappropriations and the additional General Fund revenues will not become effective unless approved by at least 2/3 of the legal voters of the Plantation of Prentiss.

10 If approved, this deorganization will result in a net savings to the General Fund of \$224,862 in fiscal year 1990-91.
12 The \$190,000 additional appropriation to Education in the Unorganized Territory will be completely offset by additional
14 General Fund revenues collected through the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund. This deorganization will also
16 result in savings to General Purpose Aid for Local Schools of \$211,162 and to Tree Growth Tax Reimbursement of \$13,700.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This amendment clarifies the deorganization process and makes explicit the procedures for assessment of property taxes 24 within Prentiss Plantation. No provision is necessary regarding the payment of Prentiss Plantation's share of any school debt 26 since the plantation has no overlapping or legal obligation to School Administrative District No. 30 at this time. The 28 amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note.
