COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1726, L.D. 2385, Bill, "An Act to Establish the International Commerce Council"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes the Office of International Commerce, which replaces the Division of Development Policy within the Department of Economic and Community Development. Most of the responsibilities and all the resources of the Division of Development Policy will be transferred to the Office of International Commerce. The remaining responsibilities of the division will be handled by the office of the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development. This internal reorganization can be implemented within the existing budgeted resources of the department.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
