22	maintenance and depreciation of the water supply for a period not exceeding 20 years if funds are available from Other Special
24	Revenue or proceeds from the sale of bonds.'
26 28	Further amend the bill by inserting after the emergency clause and before the statement of fact the following:
	'FISCAL NOTE
30 32	Enactment of this legislation would allow the Department of Environmental Protection to use available funds from Other
34	Special Revenue or proceeds from the sale of bonds to pay the costs of a public water supply.'

	STATEMENT OF FACT
38	This amendment allows the Department of Environmental
40	Protection to pay the costs of a public water supply for up to 20 years if funds are available in Other Special Revenue or from
42	applicable bond proceeds.
