SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1737, L.D. 2398, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Carrying of Firearms and Firearms Safety Programs"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 10th paragraph (page 2, lines 9 to 12 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 14th paragraph the following:

'Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 19 (page 2, lines 38 and 39 in amendment).

Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 2, lines 48 to 52 in amendment).

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the requirements imposed on the Department of Educational and Cultural Services and adjusts the fiscal note accordingly.
