HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1740, L.D. 2404, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Collection of Inspection Fees for Overboard Discharge"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of the bill would reduce the current inspection fees for residential overboard discharges by establishing a sliding scale system based on the adjusted gross income of the license holder. The bill will result in a loss of dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Protection Fund. The exact amount can not be determined at this time.'
