32	This amendment makes possession of more than 8 quarts of spirits, not labeled in accordance with the State's bottle bill,
34	prima facie evidence of illegal importation or transportation of spirits. Because provisions of the bottle bill could create
36	enforcement problems in regards to possession of malt liquor or wine containers, this amendment strikes out that portion of the
38	committee amendment creating a similar prima facie rule applicable to malt liquor or wine containers.
