24	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
26	'Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §2077, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

30	2-A. Evidence. The possession of more than 6 gallons of malt liquor or 8 guarts of wine in one or more containers that are not labeled in accordance with Title 32, section 1865, is
32	prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.'

36	STATEMENT OF FACT
38	This amendment makes possession of 8 rather than 4 quarts of spirits not labeled as required by the State's bottle bill prima
40	facie evidence of illegal importation or transportation of spirits. The amendment makes possession of 6 gallons of malt
42	liquor or 8 quarts of wine not labeled as the bottle bill requires prima facie evidence of illegal importation or
44	transportation of malt liquor or wine.
