HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1752, L.D. 2415, "Resolve, to Establish a Model Coordinated Response System for Child Abuse Referrals in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 26 in amendment) by striking out the following: "11" and inserting in its place the following: '12'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 5 by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 2, lines 35 to 38 in resolve) and inserting in its place the following:

'3. One Senator and 2 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives;'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 10th paragraph the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the first line (page 3, line 45 in resolve) by striking out the following: "approval" and inserting in its place the following: 'advice' '

This amendment clarifies the role and composition of the advisory committee.
