HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1752, L.D. 2415, "Resolve, to Establish a Model Coordinated Response System for Child Abuse Referrals in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties"

Amend the resolve in section 9 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 4, line 15 in the L.D.) by striking out the following: "Federal Expenditure Fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'Other Special Revenue funds'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This resolve allocates Title IV-E funds to establish a multi-disciplinary model project for the investigation of child abuse allegations. It also should be noted that the Governor's supplemental budget (L.D. 2282) includes an allocation for fiscal year 1990-91 for 13 staff positions and related costs for this project.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the allocation from federal to other special revenue funds and adds a fiscal note.
